

## Appointment Checklist

- ✓ If you are a new patient, download, print and complete the Patient Intake Forms available on our website or come in 10 minutes early to fill the forms out. (New Patients Only)
- ✓ Your eye examination appointment with the doctor is scheduled for 45 minutes. Please allow 5 to 10 minutes for check out.
- ✓ Bring all prescription glasses that you currently use including readers and sunglasses.
- ✓ Your eyes may be dilated as a part of your eye examination. If dilation is necessary, expect for your vision to be blurry up close and light sensitive for up to 2 hours. As such, if you are interested in looking for glasses, please come in ½ to 1 hour before your appointment to browse our selection.
- ✓ If your appointment is scheduled for 12:45pm or 4:45pm or later—please note we close directly after your examination. Therefore, if you are interested in looking for glasses, please come in ½ to 1 hour before your appointment to browse our selection.

## Contact Lenses

- ✓ Come in wearing your contact lenses for at least 1 hour.
- ✓ If you are a new patient, please bring the contact lens packaging from your contacts or a copy of your last contact lens prescription. (New Patients Only)
- ✓ Keep in mind, we have in stock Acuvue Oasys and Biofinity contact lenses. Most other contact lenses arrive next day if ordered before 3:00pm. We ship year-supplies of contact lenses direct to you free of charge.
